Honor other Club members or family members! Once a person becomes a Paul Harris Fellow, every dollar he/she donates above the initial \$1,000 gets a Foundation Recognition Point (FRP) they can give to another person. FRPs are only derived from cash contributions made after becoming Paul Harris Fellows themselves. Once FRPs are transferred, that amount deducts from the FRP column but does not alter that Rotarian's Total Recognition Amount or Paul Harris Fellow level. The Multiple Donor Form - which makes it easier for your club to contribute as a group and still receive individual recognition - is available on the foundation page of our district website!
