



## Rotary International Club Membership Goal Form

Rotary International District Governor-elect:

In line with RI's strategic plan to expand membership globally in both numbers and quality by extending Rotary to all qualified localities and increasing the number of young members and those in emerging occupations, it is important that districts and clubs set goals for accomplishments during each Rotary year. As governors you will be responsible for assisting clubs with setting and achieving membership goals that are appropriate for your district. Please distribute this form to each of your club presidents-elect for your year and collect them by 1 May.

Calculate the total amount of increase for all clubs in your district and record the number for future use. Keep the returned *Club Membership Goal Form* for your records only. You may use this information when determining which club should receive the Presidential Citation in April/May of your year. Do not send the *Club Membership Goal Forms* to RI; for the purpose of this recognition RI only requires the total amount of projected increase for all clubs in your district.

### Club Membership Goal Timetable

**International Assembly:** District governors-elect are provided membership information at the International Assembly.

**Presidents-elect Training Seminar:** RI President-elect's suggested membership goal is communicated to club presidents-elect and action plans are discussed.

**\*1 May: Club presidents-elect submit goal to district governors-elect.**

**15 May:** District governors-elect submit district goals to Rotary International, net membership increase and the organization of new clubs.
