The Presidential Citation

Summary:

The purpose of the Presidential Citation is to increase Rotary Club involvement in the Four Avenues of Service, while at the same time encouraging Rotarians' personal involvement in serving others and promoting a high standard of Rotary service in the community. The award is revised on an annual basis by the Rotary International President and traditionally highlights the President's Theme.*

Eligible Nominees:

Rotary clubs in good standing are eligible to receive this award. The eligibility requirements are revised on an annual basis, but are generally based on service activities within the Four Avenues of Service.

Selection Process:

District Governors must endorse and submit nomination forms to RI World Headquarters.

Deadline: The exact date of the deadline varies from year-to-year, however, it is in mid-April.

* If 50% of the Rotary clubs in a certain district receive the Presidential Citation, the district governor of that district is eligible to receive a special recognition from the Rotary International President.
